 Board President Allmaras called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

Approval of the Agenda
 It was moved by Alfstad and seconded by Drake to approve the agenda with the addition of Item 1 - Quarterly Review of Pledge of Securities. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of the September 9th Regular Meeting Minutes
 It was moved by Schaefer and seconded by Alfstad to approve the minutes of the September 9th regular meeting as presented. Motion carried unanimously.

Approval of the Consent Agenda
 It was moved by Schaefer and seconded by Pfeiffer to approve the consent agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously. The consent agenda consisted of the business manager report, and the bills - general fund of \$189,672.10 and the building fund of \$30,230.98, the food service fund of \$18,680.27, and the activity fund of \$5,644.59.

Monthly Committee Reports
 There were no committee meetings this month.

Principals' Reports
 Secondary Principal Hager was not in attendance tonight. Her report was shared with the board through the meeting packet.

Superintendent Report
 Superintendent Becker shared her report with the board. The first assessment of the new ND A+ testing system began on October 1st for grades K-10. Fire Prevention Week gave students in grades PreK-2 the opportunity to visit the city fire hall, meet some fire fighters and learn about fire prevention and safety. Classroom observations are underway for all teachers in their first through third year of service. Student discipline, meetings with families and staff regarding concerns and attendance are ongoing, as does work to obtain substitute teachers when needed. Lastly Becker noted updates to a few grants the district has applied for, as well as the plan for next week's professional development where PBIS will be the focus.

Teacher Report
 There was no teacher report this morning.

Student Report
 There was no student report this morning.

Discussion of Vacant Board Seat
 It was moved by Schaefer and seconded by Perleberg to appoint Lisa Longnecker to fill former Board Member Mike Jacobson's seat until June 30th. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. Longnecker had previously served on the board and has agreed to take the seat until June 30th. This seat will be up for election this coming June.

Quit Claim Deed
 It was moved by Pfeiffer and seconded by Drake to approve the Quit Claim Deed as presented. Motion carried by unanimous roll call vote. Deed grants a very small tract of land to Kent and Alyson Myhre, who farm and take care of the land connected to this tract. Travis Peterson prepared the deed. Due to the physical nature and size of the land at hand, there was no monetary requirement, however a donation of \$1,500 was made by Myhre's to the district.
