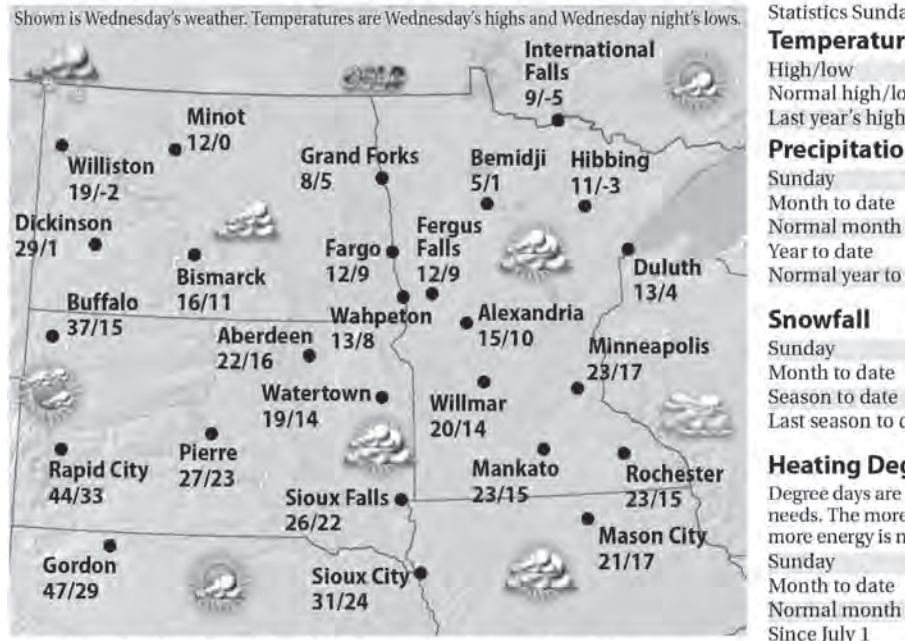

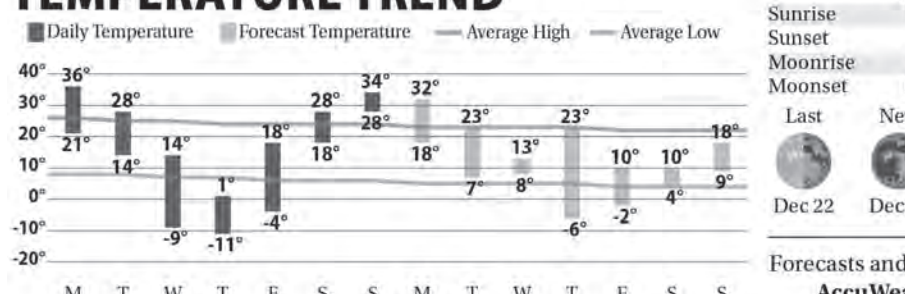
REGIONAL FORECAST
