Motion by Luke Reski, seconded by Jason Rutledge to approve a gaming permit for Kidder County School – Motion Carried

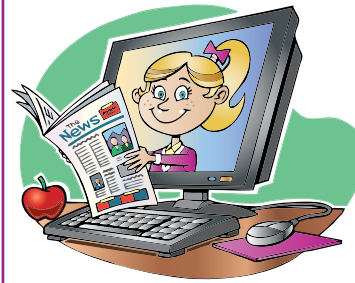
