**Custodian Daily Duties and Responsibilities**

- Scrubs, sanitizes, and supplies restroom facilities.
- Dusts furniture, walls, and equipment.

water development, fencing, conservation initiatives, federal permitting compliance, and other projects that would improve grasslands health.

SB 2386 allows food prepared in North Dakota home kitchens, which are known as cottage foods, to be sold across state lines, using the phone, internet, consignment sales or the regular mail. The bill does not allow poultry products to be sold across state lines.

**Corrections and courts**

HB 1047 requires a judge to offer up to 10 hours of post-trial counseling to jurors or alternate jurors who hear trials that included extraordinarily graphic, gruesome or emotional evidence or testimony. The counseling

must be offered to jurors who hear cases involving murder, manslaughter, negligent homicide, felony assault, domestic violence, sexual offenses, or abuse or neglect of a child. The counseling must occur within 180 days after the jury is discharged.

HB 1134, an "anti-doxxing" bill, forbids disclosing an individual's personal identifying information through writing, electronic communication, electronic publishing, or posting, if the person doing the posting is attempting to frighten or harass the subject.

HB 1299 allows a private person to break into a building if they reasonably believe that an individual inside is at imminent risk of serious bodily injury or death.

HB 1344 standardizes and clarifies when the state Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation pays

counties for inmates housed in county jails. When state facilities for inmates are full, the state may house inmates in county jails across North Dakota. An agreement between the state and county jail would need to include a minimum daily rate per inmate.

**Libraries**

HB 1420 clarifies that the State Library Coordinating Council is responsible for disbursing state grants, and that it is not responsible for distributing federal grants.

SB 2219 makes it easier for the State Library to share materials with libraries throughout the state. When the State Library culls its collections, it shares materials it no longer needs with local libraries. The bill allows the State Library to distribute the materials directly to other libraries without informing the state surplus property division, which is usually used to sell surplus property.

**Counties, townships and elections**

Under HB 1065 the state treasurer shall distribute \$16.1 million to non-oil producing counties to benefit townships in each county. The distribution is proportional to the number of township road miles in each township, when compared to the combined road miles of all townships in all non-oil producing counties.

SB 2324 says that when a portion of a home rule charter is pre-empted, superseded or invalidated, the city or county's governing body may change the affected language in the home rule charter without holding an election.

HB 1138 says a bond election must be held at least 64 days after the governing body adopts a resolution to get voter permission to borrow money and issue bonds. Under current law, a bond election may be held within 20 days after it is authorized. The 64-day election window is already required for primary, general, and special elections involving candidates and ballot measures.

**Renters' rights**

HB 1610 says a landlord may not charge a tenant a fee to accept cash, check, or a money order for any payment the landlord requires, including rent.
