A Public Hearing on the application in Case No. PU-24-351 is scheduled for March 24, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. Central Time at the Wahpeton Law Enforcement Center in the Community Room, 413 3rd Ave N, Wahpeton, ND 58075.

On October 8, 2024, Flickertail Solar Project, LLC (Flickertail) filed an application for a certificate of site compatibility concerning the location for a 300 megawatt solar energy conversion facility, the Flickertail Solar Project (Project) in Richland County, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map.

The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

Will the location and operation of the proposed Project produce minimal adverse 1. effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?

Around \$11,000 was raised at Valentine Bingo to help veterans fly for free.

Each year, Veterans Honor Flight of North Dakota/Minnesota, gives veterans a chance started four years ago. to fly to Washington, D.C. free of charge to visit memorials built in their honor.

To help keep these flights free for veterans, the group hosted Valentine Bingo at the Hankinson Community Center on Saturday, Feb. 8.

The evening started with a social hour, followed by dinner and 12 games of bingo. There

was also a silent auction and a wine pull.

Greg Paulson, owner of Hot Cakes Cafe & Lodging, catered the event.

Prizes included an ice auger, a wood pellet grill and a \$300 meat package with a wagon.

The bingo fundraisers Veterans Honor Flight of North Dakota/Minnesota held two Christmas bingo fundraisers and one St. Patrick Day bingo fundraiser.

This was the organization's first year doing Valentine bingo, close to 250 people were in attendance and the community center is booked for another Valentine bingo fundraiser next year.

"The event was a huge success, the support from the local area was amazing," said Veterans Honor Flight of North Dakota/Minnesota board member Susan Schroeder.

The money raised will help cover the cost of five flights to Washington D.C.scheduled for later this year.

"We'll be taking at least 500 veterans to Washington D.C. this year. We have a waiting list of 900, so we'll take 500 of those names off the list," David Brunsvold said.

Veterans Honor Flight of North Dakota/Minnesota is a non-profit organization created to honor America's Veterans for all their sacrifices. Flights occur in the spring and fall each year. "Online ticket sales were slow so we were a bit nervous about attendance going into this event. But the local communities proved once again how supportive and dedicated they are when it comes to veterans," Board President Jane Matejcek said.


