

Goodrich City Special September Minutes

SPECIAL MEETING regarding City Water and City Lagoons

September 10, 2026 – 5:30 pm - Goodrich City Hall

Present: Steve Hochhalter, Blane Enzminger, Karen Konschak, Steve Barreth, Diane Bellecourt (Mayor) and Pam Stewart (Auditor) by phone

Guests: John Parsons (City Water Operator), Terry Feikert, Julie Demke, Craig Bellecourt, Delilah Gesellchen

Meeting was called to order and mayor announced that the meeting was being recorded.

City Water - John Parsons presented a water report from Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) which is the result of their recent inspection. There was some discussion regarding what happened when the city received a boil order from DEQ recently, what was done to correct it and water testing

process. DEQ identified some repair to Goodrich Well #1 cement and conduit which will be fixed by the city. There was much discussion regarding the two city wells and how they work together and that Well #1 is a backup for the city. Chlorination of both wells would be required and City Council discussed the best process with Terry Feikert.

A motion was made by Steve H, to put a chlorinator system on Well #1, repair the broken concrete and conduit. Motion was seconded by Steve B. and carried. An additional motion was made by Steve B to install a water meter on Well #1 which was seconded by Blane and carried.

Another chlorination system will be purchased for Well #1. Will continue to resolve issues and comply with DEQ. John will complete the compliance report to DEQ.

Lagoons – Letter sent to the state by John Parsons regarding what we have completed so far. Interstate

Engineering is willing to help find funding to have a provisional engineering report completed. The engineering report is the first step necessary in order to apply for further funding to repair/replace lagoons etc. Karen made a motion to have Interstate Engineering help find funding for the provisional engineering report. The motion was seconded by Blane and carried.

Signage will still need to be posted stating that the lagoons are City of Goodrich property but will hold off on fencing requirements pending engineers report.

Motion to adjourn by Steve H. seconded by Blane carried
