The work generally consists of: 1. Schedule 1: Water Main Exten-

a. Base Bid: Open-cut installation of approximately 340 LF of 6-inch water main and 3,635 LF of 8-inch water main including valves, hydrants, fittings, and other associated appurtenances. Horizontal directionally drilled installation of approximately 105 LF of 8-inch water main. Jack and Bored installation of approximately 280 LF of 8-inch water main and 16-inch casing. Surface restoration will include aggregate and

grass surfacing.
2. Schedule 2: Sanitary Sewer CIPP Rehabilitation

a. Base Bid: Trenchless cured-inplace-pipe (CIPP) rehabilitation of approximately 2,977 LF of 8-inch sanitary sewer main, approximately 46 internally CIPP-sealed service lateral connections, CIPP rehabilitation of approximately 30 existing service laterals from the main to the property line, and installation of 2 sanitary sewer manholes. Open-cut

replacement of existing sanitary sewer mains/laterals will be included as necessary. Surface restoration will include asphalt pavement, curb and gutter, and landscaping.

b. 4. The Contractor shall pay the Owner \$1,700.00 for each day or part of a day that expires after the time specified for Substantial Completion of any construction schedule until the Work is substantially complete. 


