GRAVESIDE FLOWER & DECORATION GUIDELINES

There will be NO planting of flowers, shrubs or trees on the grave or around the monument.

Memorial Day – Any live plants, plastic/silk flower arrangements, or decorations put on display for Memorial Day that are not in a vase affixed to the headstone must be removed no later than two weeks after this holiday or they will be removed by the caretakers.

Special Dates – Any flowers/decorations placed on graves to commemorate special dates will be removed by the caretakers at the time of the next mowing.

Landscaping Rock – Landscaping rock on top of a grave site is not permitted. Existing rock should be removed as it is a hazard when mowing.

Private Burial of Urns – The City Office MUST be notified prior to any urn placement in the Lakeview Cemetery.

If the City of Kenmare elects to award a contract to the lowest responsible bidder, and the lowest responsible bidder does not execute a contract within ten (10) days, the bidder's bond will be forfeited to the City of Kenmare, and the City of Kenmare may award the project to the next lowest responsible bidder.

Each bidder must possess a valid North Dakota contractor's license for the full amount of their bid, as required by N.D.C.C. § 43-07-7. Each bidder MUST enclose a copy of their Contractor's License or Certificate of Renewal, issued by the North Dakota Secretary of State, and each license must be valid and dated at least 10 days prior to the date set for bid opening, as required under N.D.C.C. § 43-07-12.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with American Iron and Steel requirements of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this regulation are explained in the specifications.

Bidders are required to comply with Davis-Bacon prevailing wage requirements.
