A word from Forbes regarding the past & present

Joan Tviet Hoffman, who for many years has worked with loyal volunteers to preserve and honor the heritage of the Forbes area, is eager to inform all our readers of the events at Forbes this Friday and Saturday. She also noted several features of the community that the public should know.

- The Presbyterian Church, which now houses the museum of the Couteau Hills Historical Center, was built in 1906 and has stood proudly there ever since. It has a history of serving our community, including as a Youth Center.
- In 1976 the Couteau Hills Historical Center (CHHC) signed a 100 year lease with the North Dakota Dept of Game and Fish to give public access to Johnson's Gulch. Together with the Maud Eveans Saddle Club, the CHHC introduced riders and participants to the history of the Coteau Hills and held a campout in Johnson's
- The Shimmin family and Agnes Tveit purchased the Presbyterian Church as a Youth Center and donated it to the CHHC. In 1977 it was dedicated as Shimmin-Tveit Museum, and ever since it has preserved and shared the history of our area.
- The Prairie Life Monument, a large, artfully constructed wall comprised of bricks with the names of area people, was dedicated in 2018.

As part of the all-school reunion, we are taking the opportunity to thank our community and those beyond who have continued to support CHHC with history and finances, and enabled us to update our museum to continue preserving and sharing our history. The program will be next to the museum. Everyone is asked to please bring your lawn chair and celebrate with us.

A welcome will be given by Mayor Carl Kronberg. The emcee will be historian Tom Tveit (son of Oliver & Pat Tveit and grandson of Lewis & Agnes Tveit) Tom will speak on the theme "History through the Eyes of the Fourth Generation."

The program will include an introduction and tribute to the "baseball hall of fame," and the dedication will be by Rev. Karen (Berheim) Engelke, who was profiled in a recent *Leader*.




