Take Down Tobacco Day 2025: A national call to action to end youth nicotine addiction

On Tuesday, April 1, 2025, Foster County Public Health will join forces with advocates across the country for the National Day of Action: Take Down Tobacco Day. This nationwide movement, spearheaded by the Campaign for Tobacco-Free Kids, is dedicated to empowering youth, raising awareness about the dangers of nicotine addiction, and taking bold steps to end Big Tobacco's influence in our communities.

Take Down Tobacco Day is a powerful opportunity to shine a light on the tactics Big Tobacco uses to target young people and vulnerable populations. From flashy packaging to flavored products, the

tobacco industry continues to gamble with people's lives for profit. But together, we can expose their harmful practices and advocate for a healthier, tobacco-free future.

Every year, nearly half a million Americans and more than 1,000 North Dakotans lose their lives to commercial tobacco-related illnesses, and countless others are affected by nicotine addiction. Youth are especially vulnerable, with e-cigarettes and flavored products acting as gateways to lifelong addiction.

The most recent data from North Dakota's Tobacco Prevention and Control Program

for high school and middle school students shows most youth choose NOT to use tobacco products. These statistics highlight the positive, healthy choices of North Dakota youth and are from the statewide North Dakota 2023 Youth Risk Behavior Survey results.

For those in high school (9th-12th graders):

• 94.6% currently do NOT smoke

• 81.2% do NOT use vape devices

• 96.6% do NOT use smokeless tobacco

• 95.8% do NOT use cigars For those in middle school (7th-8th graders):

• 97.4% currently do NOT

smoke

• 92.4% do NOT use vape devices

• 98.8% do NOT use smokeless tobacco

• 98.9% do NOT use cigars

“Big Tobacco's deceptive tactics have targeted our youth and glamorized addiction for too long. On Take Down Tobacco Day, we say, ‘Enough is enough.’ Together, we can expose the truth, protect our communities, and take down tobacco for good,” said Robin Simonson, Prevention Coordinator from Foster County Public Health.
