Please take notice that BNI Coal Ltd., 2360 35th Avenue SW, Center, ND 58530-9499 has submitted applications to the North Dakota Public Service Commission for Renewal No.6 and Revision No. 19 to Permit BNCR-9401, approved on August 16, 1995, to engage in surface coal mining and reclamation operations. The area for which a permit renewal is sought includes 338.28 acres in Sections 5 and 8, T141N, R83W and Section 32, T142N, R83W. This area is in Oliver County, North Dakota and is shown on the accompanying map. Renewal No. 6 will extend the permit term another five years. The next five-year permit term will be from August 16, 2025 to August 16, 2030. The permit revision updates the Legal and Financial Section, Extended Mine Plan, Environmental Resources, and
