Structure Replacements,
Roadway
Realignment and Mill and Overlay
Work to be performed by
Consultant includes:

Construction Engineering
including but not limited to project
administration, construction sur-
vey, construction observation,
material testing and record keep-
ing utilizing the NDDOT CARS
system. All work shall be per-
formed to NDDOT standards and
procedures.

Firms are invited to submit a
proposal for the project listed
above. The Proposals shall pro-
vide the following information:
• Past Performance
• Ability of professional personnel
• Willingness to meet time and
budget requirements
• Location
• Current, and projected work-
loads of the persons and/or firms
• Related experience on similar
projects
• Recent and current work for the
County
• Project understanding, issues, &
approach

The proposal pages shall be
numbered and must be limited to
10 pages in length. Proposals that
exceed the 10 page length
requirement will not be consid-
ered. The cover letter will not be
counted as one of the 10 pages.
The proposal should list the per-
sonnel who will be assigned to
work on the project,
including titles, education, and
work experience. LaMoure
County
will only consider proposals
received prior to 11:00 AM, May
29, 2025. Late proposals will be
deemed unresponsive.

The consultant's proposal may
include an appendix. Resumes,
references, a statement of quali-
fications and other materials outlin-
ing experience may be included in
an appendix. The appendix will
not be considered as a part of the
10 page proposal. Each proposal
will be evaluated by a selection
committee.

LaMoure County will conduct
interviews. The County plans to
interview up to three (3) of the
most qualified engineering firms
based on whose proposals most
clearly meet the RFP require-
ments. Interviews will take place
on a date to be determined by the
County. Firms not selected to be
interviewed will be notified in writ-
ing.

Fees shall be negotiated with the
successful firm. If the fee can-
not be agreed upon, the County
reserves the right to terminate
negotiations, and then negotiate
with the second and third ranked
firms in order, if necessary, until a
satisfactory contract has been
negotiated.

All costs associated with the

proposal shall be borne by the
proposer. The County reserves
the right to reject any and/or all
proposals and to not award con-
tracts for any and/or all projects.
