In our recent study, we went over a list of particular sins in Colossians 3:5 that God's people are commanded to put away, by the enabling power of the Holy Spirit. Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience.3 Paul writes such things to those who used to live in disobedience to God, to remind them where they were headed before Christ saved them and what would have happened if they had continued to live in such a sinful lifestyle. The wrath of God"

describes God's holy anger against sin. When God is wrathful, He is not like people so often can be, who are out of control and acting purely in unbridled emotion. God's wrath results from His absolute holiness and inevitable hatred of sin. This results in His pouring out just punishment.

Many people, even professing Christians, do not like the theme of God's wrath and either ignore or downplay it. But it is a theme that cannot be ignored if one is following the Scriptures. One of the main problems people have with the concept of God's wrath is in thinking that it is inconsistent with His love. But such thinking is due to a wrong view of what love really is. Fourth of July Dipped Strawberries Recipe: From the kitchen of: Joy Zimmerman

Ingredients:

24 strawberries

1 C. white candy melts or white

chocolate melting wafers

red, white and blue nonpareil sprinkles

Directions:

Rinse the strawberries and pat dry. Melt candy according to directions - don't over heat. Dip the strawberries into the melted chocolate about 2/3 of the way. Then dip into the sprinkles about 1/3 of the strawberry. So that the white is showing a little.

Place them onto a baking sheet lined with wax or parchent paper. If the chocolate is not setting up, set them in the refrigerator to harden. Best if used the same day.

Tip - after rinsing the strawberries let sit out to dry.
