Attorney general: JMHCC did not violate open meetings law

North Dakota Attorney General Drew Wrigley has issued an opinion that Jacobson Memorial Hospital Care Center (JMHCC) did not violate open meetings laws by refusing public access to meetings unrelated to public funds.

Alan Lindemann, a former employee of JMHCC, requested an opinion from the office of the attorney general asking whether JMHCC is a "public entity" subject to the open meetings laws and whether JMHCC violated the open meetings laws by refusing public access to its May 31, 2022, and June 28, 2022, meetings.

On Sept. 10, the attorney general issued an opinion stating JMHCC is a "public entity" subject to open meetings laws only to the extent it

is supported by or expends public funds. The opinion also states JMHCC did not violate open meetings laws by refusing public access to those meetings, because the meetings did not relate to public funds.

The opinion states Lindemann wished to attend the May 31, 2022, and June 28, 2022, JMHCC board meetings. Lindemann appeared at the May 31, 2022, meeting and addressed the board "for the first 5-10 minutes to state a small message regarding the hospital," but was not allowed to attend the full meeting. Lindemann, who was not employed by JMHCC at the time, complains he was "escorted out or told to leave the meeting" by JMHCC's chief executive officer at the time.

In his analysis, Wrigley states the definition of a "public entity" subject to open

records and open meetings laws includes "(o)rganizations or agencies supported in whole or in part by public funds, or expending public funds."

The analysis includes definitions of public funds. Payments from Medicare, Medicaid and private health insurance companies are not public funds, Wrigley states. However, grants from the city's sales tax funds are considered public funds.

"It is my opinion that JMHCC is a 'public entity' subject to the open records and meetings laws to the extent it is supported by and expends the city's sales tax funds. Records and meetings related to such funds and their uses are open unless otherwise protected by law," Wrigley states.

The portion of a meeting which does not involve public business

is not required to be open to the public, the opinion states.

'While JMHCC is a 'public entity' and is subject to the open meetings law regarding the use of the sales tax proceeds received from the city, only the portions of the meetings concerning the use of

those funds are subject to the open meeting laws," Wrigley states.

"My office has reviewed the meeting minutes from the May 31, 2022, and June 28, 2022, meetings, and based on the minutes, the board did not discuss the approval or expenditure of those public funds during the meetings," he states, indicating JMHCC's board did not violate the open meetings law when it prohibited Lindemann or others from attending its May 31, 2022, and June 28, 2022, meetings.
