Last month’s meeting minutes were reviewed. Approved as submitted.

Agenda items were finalized.

Agenda items were finalized and financial report was reviewed.

Late water bills were discussed. 3 disconnect notices for March were issued, total in disconnects is \$625.17.

Bockovens water bill was discussed. They are requesting a credit adjustment on their bill, due to having let the water run within their home, to avoid freeze-ups. A credit will be issued of \$260.00.

Nathan gave the monthly engineer report, and DEQ update.

John Brown gave the monthly PW report. He has spoken with Sewage Pump and Lift Station, and that project will begin soon. The coal/boiler room at the school building is seeing deterioration in the walls.

The building will need to be taken down, and options will be looked into for the next meeting. John will also order some speed limit signs for Main Street, and get those replaced and put up.

The renal agreement for the Sherwood Shares Food Pantry was given to the council, and will be reviewed at the next meeting.

The City Spring Cleanup Week has been scheduled for May 14th thru May 21st. There will be two roll-off dumpsters placed in front of the school building. Signs will be made, and placed around town.

Garett gave a copy of the Sales Tax Ordinance to the council members, to review further, and will be discussed at next months meeting.

Dave made a motion to pay the monthly bills. Seconded by Will. All board members present were in favor. None opposed. Motion carried.
