Attending was Rich Bjerklie, Rod Kleppe, Bob Humann, Mike Heying, Clark Haas and John Wald.

The purpose of the meeting was to approve the second and final reading of Model "D" Ordinance Floodplain Management with changes from the first reading and to answer any questions anyone may have about the amendments or revisions in the ordinance.

Mayor Moos asked if anyone was present to discuss the Floodplains Management Ordinance or if anyone had any questions about the ordinance. After asking the question three times Mayor Moos asked for a motion to approve the second and final reading with the changes approved from the first reading. Wald made a motion to approve the second and final motion with the changes done, Bjerklie seconded, all hands raised in favor, motion carried.

Wald motioned to adjourn, Heying seconded, motion carried.

Napoleon City Hall

The Board of Equalization meeting was held Monday, April 7th, 2025, at 6:30 p.m. at Napoleon City Hall. Present were Mayor Todd Moos, Aldermen Rich Bjerklie, Rod Kleppe, Bob Humann, Clark Haas, and City Auditor Colleen Fettig.

Mayor Moos called the meeting to order.

Minutes from April 1st, 2024, meeting was approved at the May 6th, 2024, meeting with Kleppe making the motion to approve the minutes, Bjerklie seconded the motion, motion carried.

Trish Laine, Logan County Tax Equalization Director presented the Homestead Credit applications, of which 27 were accepted in 2025. Laine also presented the Disabled Veterans Property Tax Credit, which 5 were accepted for 2025. There were also 9 applications for the certificate of Real Estate Exemptions accepted.

Commercial Sales Ratio is 85.99%. Trish Laine, Logan County Tax Equalization Director said she is recommending a 6% increase for 2025. Kleppe motioned to increase the Commercial Sales Ratio 6%, Haas seconded, all hands raised in favor, motion carried.

Residential Sales Ratio for Napoleon is 83.32%. Residential Sales Ratio for Logan County is 88.00%. Trish Laine, Logan County Tax Equalization Director, informed the council that numbers need to be between 90-100%. Laine recommended for Napoleon a 7% increase in residential structures. Haas motioned to increase the residential structures 7%, Kleppe seconded, all hands raised in favor, motion carried.

Humann motioned to approve the valuation 2025 Assessment Book, Bjerklie seconded, all hands raised in favor, motion carried.

Kleppe motioned to adjourn the meeting, Bjerklie seconded, motion carried. Meeting adjourned.
