Business manager Wald reported issues with uploading FCCU payroll files. Shawn Puklich filed the necessary paperwork to run as a member of the school board. The second grade class was awarded the Just Right Reader grant for \$6,872.25. The grant is to be used for North Dakota ELA Standards-aligned classroom library sets and five Take Everywhere Packets for students and their families. Wald discussed various activity fund balances and was given the direction from the board to clear up some of the balances as in prior years.
The sports committee met on March 13, 2025 and discussed cooping on baseball and track. On March 24, 2025 the committee met with South Border in Ashley to discuss cooping with baseball starting in 2025-2026. Leier moved to approve to coop with South Border for baseball in the 2025-2026 school year. Motion seconded by Schumacher and all voted aye. Puklich moved to approve dissolving the baseball coop with Gackle-Streeter. Motion seconded by Gross and all voted aye.
Elementary principal Weigel gave an update on reading month. Spring parent teacher conferences had a 95% parent participation. Terrence Talley presented an uplifting message on mental health and finding support within the school. Elementary students will be attending various field trips.
High school principal/AD Berger gave an update on spring testing. Berger attended the NDIAAA spring conference. Kali Fettig will be the new head volleyball coach with Abreena Klitzke and Shania Nieuwsma as the assistant coaches. Still looking for a JH volleyball coach. There is a sports coop meeting scheduled for April 15th. An update was given on track and boys' golf. There was discussion on the football field lights. Gackle-Streeter would like to join Napoleon's trap shooting. The activities banquet is May 7th.
Superintendent Bjerklie reported that the SEL 7 Mindets will be exploring so the academic team will be looking at either continuing with the current curriculum or looking at a different approach. Several staff members attended a Title IX meeting. A quote for chromebooks and Ipads will be presented at May's board meeting. Ancillary wages along with going into executive session for principal contracts will be on the agenda in May. The board will go over the business manager's evaluation with Wald. An update was given on the J1 visa program for teachers. Several history teacher interviews have been conducted. An in house elementary teacher will be transferring to the open special ed position. A list of classes offered to students that are outside of the school building through CREA/CRACTC/BASC/GWN/RACTC was given.
