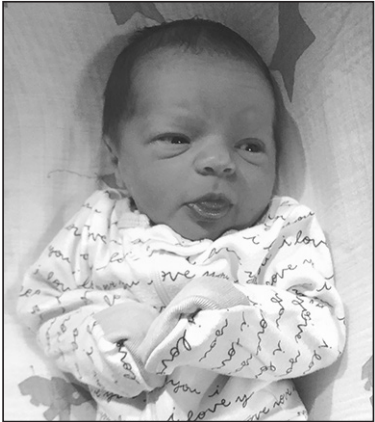
Enough To Have Their Own Sports Teams
