Deputy Friez had State Radio page out Napoleon ambulance to Highway 34 and 39th Ave SE, Napoleon where the reporting party was waiting with the victims.

When Deputy Friez arrived, he found two victims, 53-yearold Paula Christenson and 41-year-old Eric Seewalker.
