# UTV Mishap Sends One To The Hospital

According to the Logan County Sheriff’s Dept., Logan County Deputy Sheriff Kyle Friez received a call at about 12:25 a.m. Sun., June 22 for an UTV injury accident and that an ambulance was needed east of Napoleon.

Deputy Friez had State Radio page out Napoleon ambulance to Highway 34 and 39th Ave SE, Napoleon where the reporting party was waiting with the victims.

When Deputy Friez arrived, he found two victims, 53-year-old Paula Christenson and 41-year-old Eric Seewalker.

Christenson had injuries requiring medical attention and was transported by Napoleon Ambulance to CHI St. Alexis in Bismarck, while Seewalker refused medical treatment.

Through Deputy Friez’s investigation he determined that Seewalker was operating a side-by-side UTV with Christenson as his passenger on private property in rural Logan County when he turned too sharp and the UTV tipped or rolled. They were then brought in a pickup to Highway 34 to meet the ambulance.
