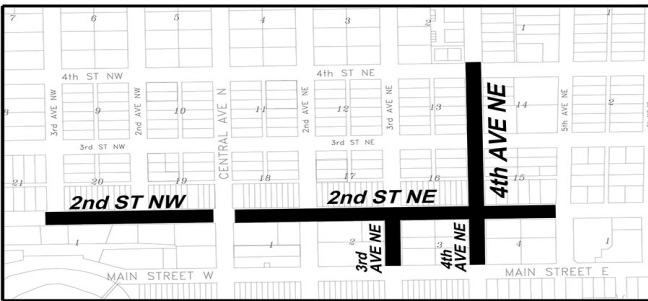

**RESOLUTION NO. 2486
RESOLUTION DECLARING
NECESSITY OF IMPROVEMENTS
IN PAVING IMPROVEMENT
DISTRICT NO. 131**
 NDDOT Project Nos. (UGP-2-990(068) PCN 24181) (SU-CPU-2-990(069) PCN 24239)
 IT IS RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF VALLEY CITY, BARNES COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA,
 (1) It is necessary and expedient for the City of Valley City, North Dakota, to approve street reconstruction, and work incidental thereto, upon and along the streets and avenues contained within Paving Improvement District No. 131 ("the District"), which was created by Resolution No. 2481 on May 5, 2025.
 (2) According to the Engineer's Report and Estimate of Probable Costs for Paving Improvement District No. 131, which was approved by Resolution 2485 on May 20, 2025, the City of Valley City, North Dakota, calls for reconstruction of the following streets and avenues in the district:
 2nd Street N from 3rd Avenue NW to 5th Avenue NE; 3rd Avenue NE from Main Street East to 2nd Street NE; 4th Avenue NE from Main Street East to 4th Street NE.
 (3) The cost of improvements to the City will be paid from federal highway funds, city infrastructure funds, and special assessments (estimated to be approximately 12 percent of the total cost). Special assessments will be levied against the property within the District benefitted by the improvements in amounts proportionate to and not exceeding the benefits, except that, as authorized by N.D.C.C. § 40-24-10, the City of Valley City reserves its option to provide for the payment by general taxation of all the taxable property in the municipality of not more than one-fifth of this cost. The District contains the streets and avenues as described in this Resolution and includes the following land and territory within the corporate limits of the City of Valley City, North Dakota, to wit:

DEER GUN	November 7 12:00 noon (CT) 16 1/2 Day Season	November 23	All units	Restricted to type of deer and unit described on license. Type of deer includes species and whether antlerless or antlered (at least one visible antler). Note exception for white-tailed deer hunters in units 4B, 4C, 4D and 4E. Orange clothing required.
MUZZLELOADER	November 28 12:00 noon (CT)	December 14	Statewide	Restricted to white-tailed deer only and type of deer described on license. No unit restrictions. Orange clothing required.
YOUTH DEER	September 19 12:00 noon (CT)	September 28	Statewide	11-, 12- and 13-year-olds – Any antlerless deer is legal.* 14- and 15-year-olds – Any deer is legal.* Orange clothing required. <i>*Hunting units 4A-4F, 3B1 and 3B2 a special license is required to hunt mule deer. These licenses are valid only in the unit specified on the license.</i>

 Also in the Singles Draw, Rylyn Johnson, who joined the tennis team in March having never played competitive tennis before, had a very good first season. She and partner Skye Nielson were 3-0 in doubles during the team tournament. She did not pick up a win in the singles tournament, but held her own. Her opening draw was against Shireen Durrani of West Fargo Sheyenne. Durrani, who would take third, won in straight sets 6-0, 6-0. In the consolation round, Johnson Ali Toay of Fargo North. after dropping the first set 6-0, Johnson came back to take the second set 6-4 to force a super tie-break. The two would battle the entire set with Toay finally taking it 10-8. Chloe Liebersbach picked up a win in the singles draw. After dropoig, straight set decision to Hawn Lemu of Grand Forks

Central 6-2, 6-1, she would bounce back and defeated Breelyn Lacina of Wahpeton 6-2, 6-0. She would face Taylor Cameron of Fargo Shanley 7-6(3), 6-3 and fall one match short of playing in a state qualifier.
 Coach Nielson says, “I couldn’t be prouder of the team as a group. Everyone showed up ijn a big way. Having Georgia reach the semifinals and my daughters taking the EDC championship is surreal.”
 The State tournament will begin on Thursday with the team competition. The singles and doubles draw will begin on Frdiay.
 Valley City’s Georgia Zaun will face Abby Mullally of Bismarck St. Mary’s. IN the doubles draw, Skye and Kailee Nielson will face Ava Flemmer and Joya Martian of Bismarck Legacy.
Hi-Liner tennis falls in state qualifying match
 There will be a new

state champion in girls tennis. The Valley City Hi-Liners, the 2024 state champion, fell to Fargo Davies 3-2 in a state qualifying match at the Eastern Dakota Conference tournament in Fargo.
 The Hi-Liners were 1-2 in the team portion of the EDC Tournament. Valley City, seeded fourth in the tournament, opened up with a 3-2 win over West Fargo Horace.
 In the singles matches, Alyssa Sommerfeld defeated Georgia Zaun 6-0, 6-1. The Hi-Liners would, however, pick up wins at number two and three singles. Kailee Nielson defeated Ellie Heilman 6-0, 6-0 at number two singles and Chloe Liebersbach defeated Macy Mack 6-4, 6-2 at number three.
 The two teams split the doubles matches. Skye Nielson and Rylyn Johnson won at number one doubles 7-6 (7-5), 6-4 over Lilia Rexin and Hailey Rich-

ards. Lexi Svenning-sen and Sara Beierle lost a heartbreaker at number two doubles to Katelyn Posl and Bre Heilman . The Hawks’ duo won the first set 6-1. Svenningsen and Beierle came back to take the second set 6-3. In the super tie-break, Posl and Heilman slipped by 13-11 to take the match.
 In the semifinals, Valley City met up with West Fargo Sheyenne. The teams split the doubles matches. Skye Nielson and Rylyn Johnson defeated Annika Knodle and Ashly Duffy 7-5, 6-1 at number one doubles. Anna Mauch and Kendall Bartnick of Sheyenne took number two singles over Lexi Svenningsen and Sara Beierle. Like the Horace match, Svenningsen and Beierle lost the first set 6-4, but came back to win the second set 6-3. In the super tie-break, Mauch and Bartnick won 16-14 in a thrilling set. In the singles matches, the Mus-

tangs swept the Hi-Liners. Sarea Gu defeated Georgia Zaun 6-1, 6-1. Shireen Durrani defeated Kailee Nielson 2-6, 6-4, 10-6. And Avni Banerjee got by Chloe Liebersbach 6-1, 6-1 to take the match 4-1.
 In the state qualifying match, the Hi-Liners faced Fargo Davies, a team Valley City lost to 5-4 during the regular season. In doubles, Skye Nielson and Rylyn Johnson continued to play well with another straight set win. They defeated Grace Wanzek and Olivia Sandvik 6-4, 6-4. It came down to number two doubles, Ariel Bahn and Mia Hozak defeated Lexi Svenningsen and Chloe Liebersbach 6-1, 6-4. At number one singles Tanis Lee of Davies defeated Georgia Zaun 6-1, 6-3. At number two singles, Kailee Nielson swept Ava Eslinger 6-1, 6-1. number three singles to see who was going to state. Taya Laidlaw swept Chloe Liebersbach in straight

sets 6-2, 6-2.
 Coach Nielson said after the match, “With the loss, we didn’t state qualify for the first time in 5 years and it stings. But you know what? The sun still rose the next day. We win or we grow – no other options. I believe our team grew a ton. Four out of our seven players had never been here before and they did so good under the pressure. Lexi is an 8th grader and Sara is a 9th grader that had limited varsity experience last year. Chloe is an 8th grader that never even practiced varsity last year. Rylyn is a junior that came out for the first time this year and was a huge positive when it came to team culture and her play on the court. They gave their all, were coachable, and hit our pillars. Watch out for these Hi-Liners next season in the team regional tournament!”
 The Hi-Liners ended the season with a 9-6 overall record.
