Each qualified bid will be recorded, and the highest overall bid and bidder will be announced out loud. The highest bidder will have 10 days (July 27th@ 5pm) to complete payment to the Sheyenne Valley Area Career and Technology Center by Certified Check at which time a bill of sale will be generated. 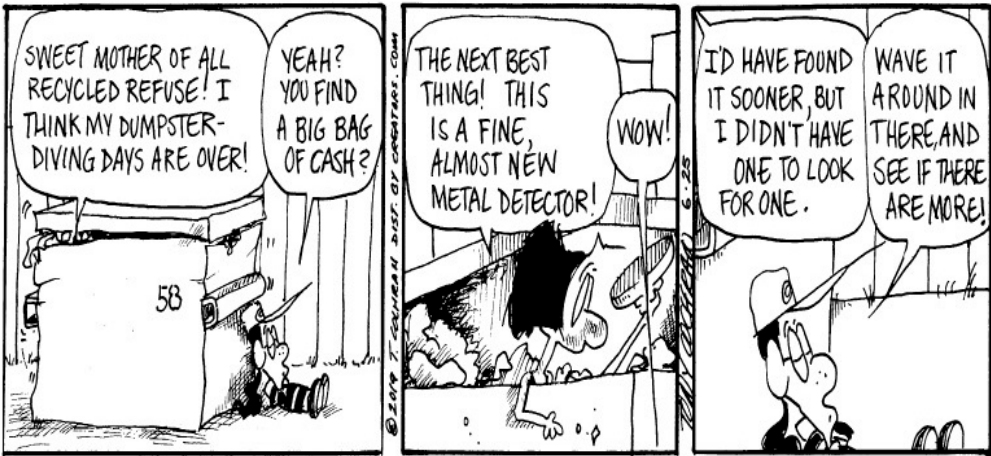
