

He worked Saturday after the storm and jumped right in and did a fantastic job. Andrea Hetland will soon be done with training and will go on probation. Ian has put in his two weeks? notice as he decided this job was not for him so we will have one opening. Chris Westerhausen has retired. A dispatcher and a trainee were working when the sirens went off for the tornado warning on June 20th. Sarah and a night shift supervisor came in at 10:30 to assist. Phones were extremely busy and overwhelmed. Jason Thiel came up and added another phone. There were 219 calls for service, 480 emergency and non-emergency calls, 20 agencies were called out in the first three hours and 1386 phone calls on two of the counsels. The team handled it extremely well. Coordination among agencies was amazing. A SIRT tower will be built in Valley City. An agreement with the City of Valley City was approved to be signed. A new repeater is being installed today. Coverage is still being tested. A mobile-to-mobile program will be added in July. We are on the transition list. Once timeline is known, Sarah will work with agencies getting the sign-off on programming. Most pre-work is done. It's a matter of starting training and looking at that once we get to on-boarding. We were asked to participate in a grant for a pilot project for Safe Road Safe Street for All grant. This will provide a comprehensive road safety plan. The grant will pay for a CAD to CAD integration with Sutsman County. This is an in-kind grant so it wouldn't cost the county any dollars except for Sarah's time.
