

Regular season ends for Storm

The Grant County/ Flasher track and field athletes made a strong showing in the NDHSAA Southwest Region Meet held Saturday in Dickinson, posting multiple personal records and solid placements across a range of events - setting the stage for a promising performance at the upcoming state track meet.

perfor-Standout mances came from sophomore Elijah Ottmar, who claimed first place in the shot put with a personal record of 49' 8", while also earning a seventh-place finish in discus with a toss of 126' 10". Fellow thrower Landan Zenker, a senior, secured third in shot put with a PR of 45' 3" and eighth in discus at 123' 10". Both athletes have qualified for state in their respective events.

"Our throwers have been pushing hard all season," said Head Coach Mike Mayer. "Eli and Landan are ranked in the top nine going into state, and I'm excited to see how they finish."

On the girls' side, junior Adison Vetter made a big impact in the hurdles, taking second in the 100m hurdles (16.92) and placing seventh in the 300m hurdles with a time of 50.27.

Coach Mayer expressed pride in his team's growth: "Overall the season was good. We had some athletes really improve from previous years. I'm hopeful this success carries into next year and motivates everyone to push for even more."

With several athletes headed to state and others setting new personal milestones, the future looks bright for Grant County/ Flasher track and field. Mens Results
