Patrick Diehl made a motion to allow the QRU to make the purchase of the Zoll Monitor. Bailey Stewart Seconded, all council member voting “aye” and motion carried.

Park Board report on the old grocery store. Shannon still is waiting for bids to come back. Water Meters – request an updated quote from DSG.

TJ has reported 5 water bills that have been paid in full.

Emmuas Cemetery mowing bid was submitted for the year. Bailey Stewart made the motion to accept the bid from Pete and Val Reis. Tony Zenker Seconded, all council member voting “aye” and motion carried. Legion Hall Soffit and

Gutter repair – Getting bids and checking into a grant to help with the bill.

Hammer Down Special Permit for alcohol for a wedding in September. Bailey Stewart made a motion to approve the special permit. Patrick Diehl Seconded, all council member voting “aye” and motion carried. Hammer Down – Gaming Permit – Tony Zenker made the motion to approve. Bailey Stewart Seconded, all council member voting “aye” and motion carried.

The Seat – Gaming Permit – Patrick Diehl made the motion to approve. Tony Zenker Seconded, all council member voting “aye” and motion carried.

CD – Bailey made a motion to put between 100,000.00 to 250,000.00 in a 6 month or 9-month CD. Depending on what kind of rate we can get. Bailey Stewart made the motion. Patrick Diehl Seconded, all council member voting “aye” and motion carried.

With no further business, Patrick Diehl made a motion to adjourned and Pete Reis seconded all council members voting “aye” and motion carried. Mayor Hanson adjourned the meeting at 9:18 pm MT.
