ATTENTION ALL PROPERTY OWNERS CITY OF MINOT NOTICE TO CUT TALL WEEDS OR GRASS

Property owners in the City of Minot are required to mow weeds or grass, before they exceed 8 inches tall, Under Chapter 22 (Nuisances) of the City of Minot Code of Ordinances.

If the tall weeds or grass on a property is determined to be in excess of 8 inches tall, such weeds or grass must be cut within 48 hours. Additional exemptions are outlined in City Ordinance section 22-9. Otherwise, the City of Minot will arrange for cutting; and the cost of such work will be assessed against the property.
