Fire hydrants will be flushed this week, the Reverse Osmosis machines have been cleaned, and Electric Pump will be at the Water Plant on Wednesday to finish installing the rail system in the pit. Presnell reported the Aqua Pure contract for Water Plant chemicals will be going up 10% in May, and the bi-annual lagoon discharge report is complete. Presnell also reported on an inquiry into a fireworks permit for the city. Fleming made a motion to accept the report. Dauenhauer seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

 GIS mapping was discussed, and Hirschert reported that work on that should begin at the end of the month.

Fleming made a motion to approve a building permit for Deb Omoth, Nicolaas VanTonder, Justin McDonald, Lynn Brost, and the New Rockford Eagles. Dauenhauer seconded the motion. Discussion was held on setbacks. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Fleming made a motion to designate the New Rockford Transcript as the official newspaper for the city. Dauenhauer seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Fleming made a motion to approve the three special event permits for Hanson's Bar and one special event permit for Buck-it's Bar. Dauenhauer seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Richter made a motion to approve the two street closure requests for Buck-it's Bar. Dauenhauer seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Dauenhauer made a motion to approve the excavating permit for Shantel Anderson. Richter seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

A citizen comment form was received and reviewed by Commissioners regarding the Casey's General Store garbage. Discussion was held on the comments, and Presnell informed the commissioners that he already sent a letter to Casey's Corporate office regarding the issue and is waiting to hear back.
