NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on April 9th, 2026, a special election will be held for the purpose of determining whether Muskego Township of Renville County, North Dakota, shall be authorized to levy an amount equal to one hundred percent over and above the basic legal limitation prescribed in Chapter 57-15 N.D.C.C.;

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the total amount of property tax revenue of said taxing district for the year 2025 was \$12,294.45 and that the total amount thereof property tax to be expended is \$12,294.45;

That the estimated expenditures for the fiscal year (FY) 2027 will be \$24,588.90; for the FY 2028 \$24,711.84; for the FY 2029 \$24,835.39; for the FY 2030 \$24,959.56; for the FY 2031 \$25,084.37.

That the amount of tax levy in excess of the statutory limit which the Board seeks authority to make for Tax Year 2026 is \$12,294.45 for TY 2027 \$12,355.92; for TY 2028 \$12,417.70

for TY 2029 \$12,479.78; and for TY 2030 \$12,542.18.

That such special election will be held on the 9th day of April, 2026, at the home of the township Clerk, Georgette Bradley, 3570 73rd St NW, Berthold, ND, and the polls shall be open from 6:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m.

That the form of the ballot shall be as follows:
